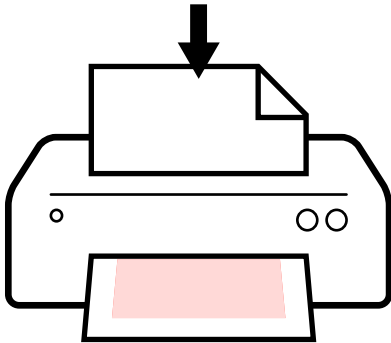


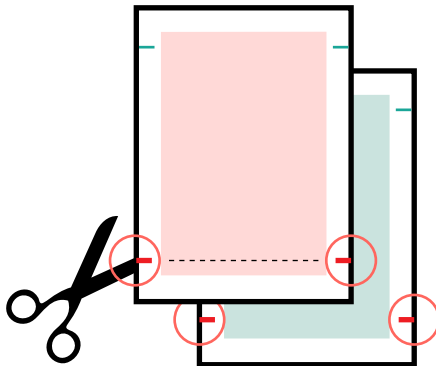
GROWTH CHART: INSTRUCTIONS

Children who are under nine years of age, who weigh between 40 and 80 lbs (18 – 36 kg) or are less than 4' 9" (145 cm) tall are safest in a booster seat. Without a booster seat, an adult seat belt rides too high on the belly and neck and can cause serious internal injuries in the event of a crash. Boost up and be safe!

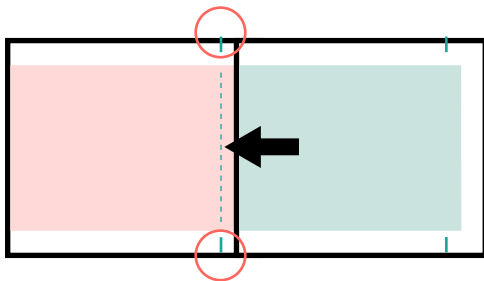
Use this fun growth chart to help track your child's growth. We've marked the height where they can graduate out of their booster seat – have fun!



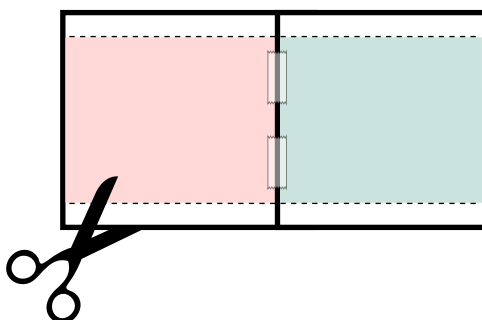
- 1** Print this PDF. The complete package is 8 pages.

- 3** Lay the trimmed edges across and cover the blue line on each page. Each page is lettered; match **A** to **A**, **B** to **B**, and so on, and attach together with tape or glue.



- 4** Trim off remaining white edges. You're done!

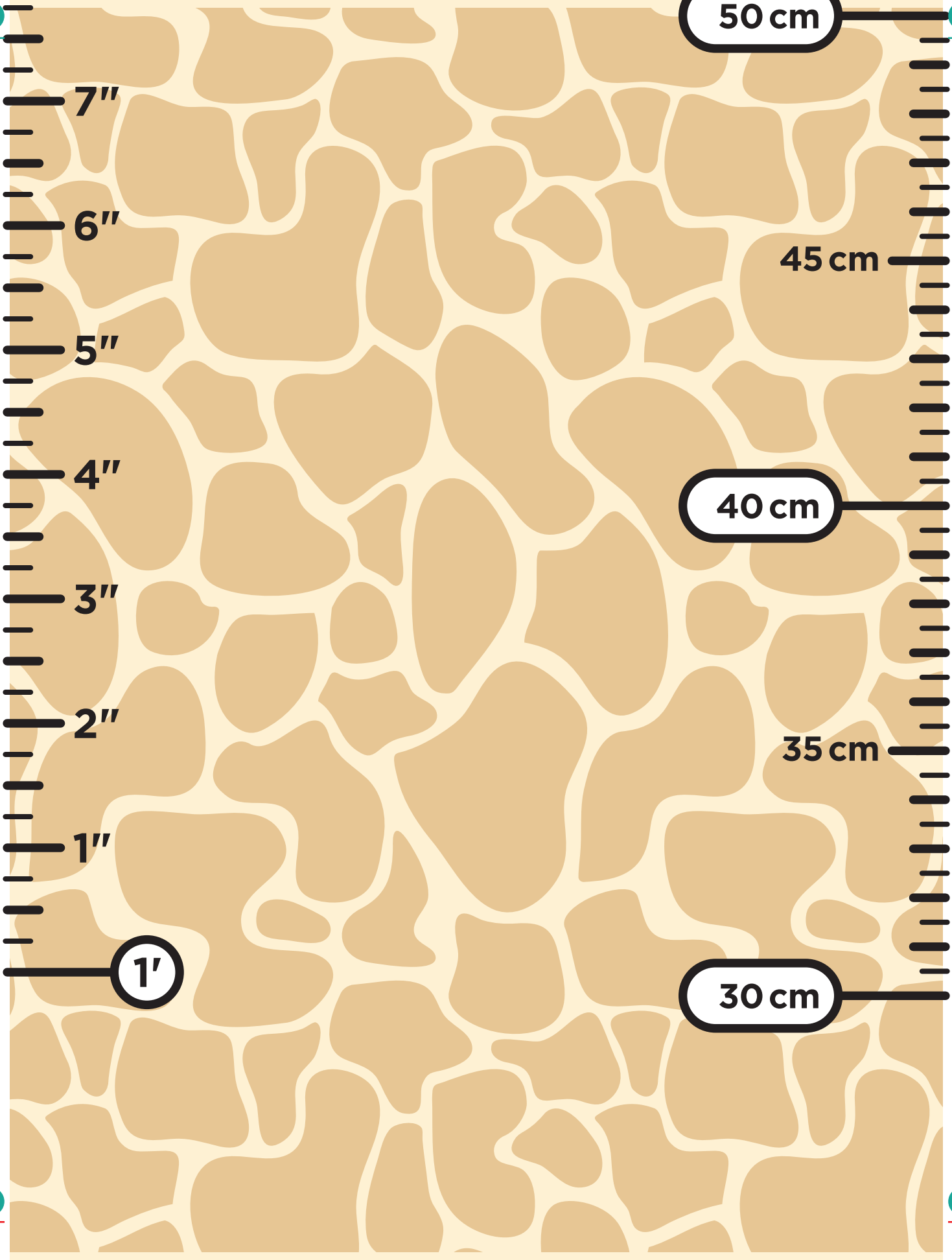

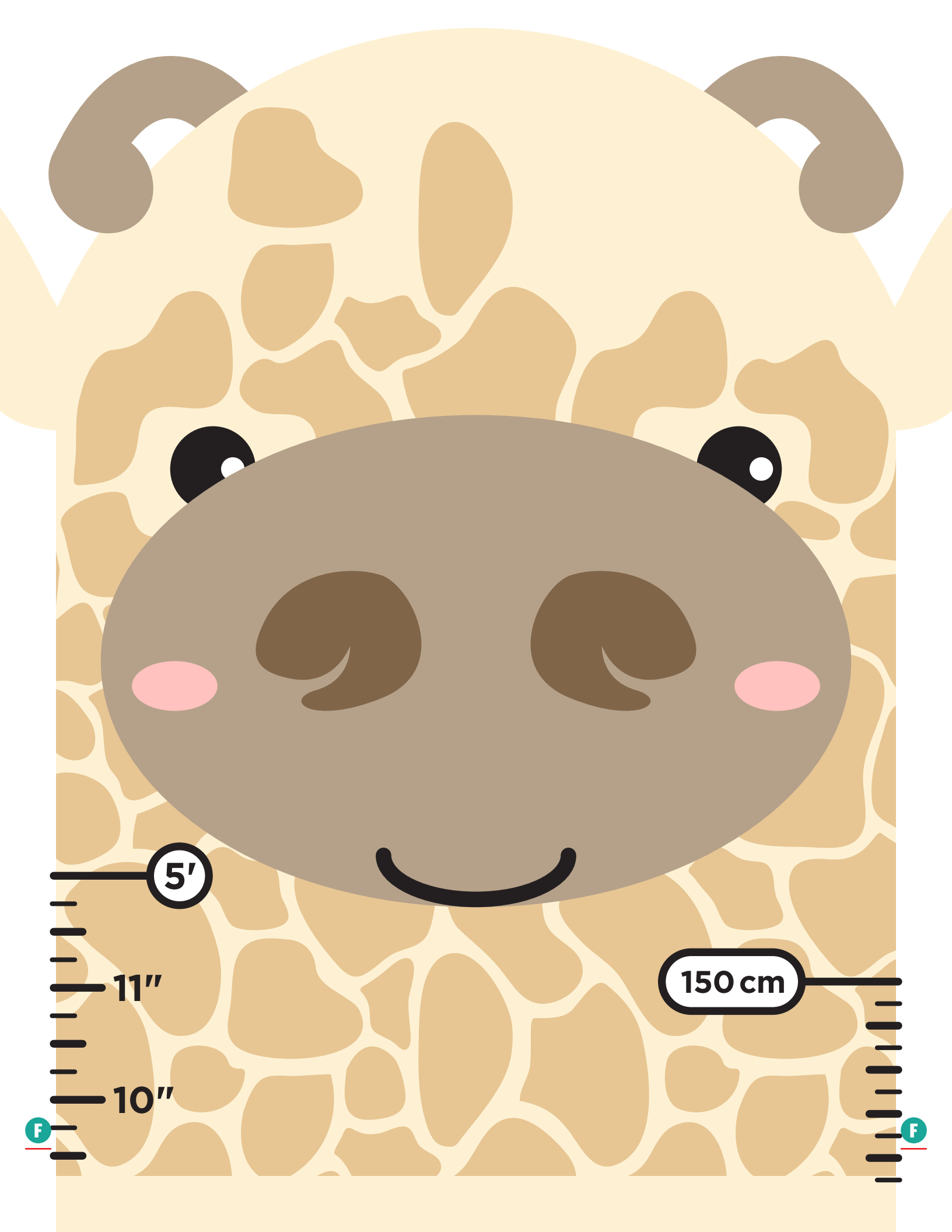
