
Forward-Facing Safety Seats

22 pounds (10 kilograms) to at least 40 pounds (18 kilograms)

When your child is one year of age <u>and</u> weighs at least 22 pounds (10 kilograms), <u>and</u> can walk, your child should use a forward-facing seat. Keep your child in this seat until at least 40 pounds (18 kilograms). It is the law in Alberta.

Read your vehicle and safety seat instructions.



Tether strap is attached to vehicle and is pulled tight.

Seat belt or Universal Anchorage System is tight to hold the seat in the vehicle.
