

Rear-Facing Safety Seats

**Read your vehicle
and safety seat
instructions.**

Birth to 1 year and 22 pounds (10 kilograms) and walking

Babies must be in a rear-facing seat when in the vehicle. **It is the law in Alberta.** It is safest for babies to stay rear-facing until they are at least one year of age and weigh at least 22 pounds (10 kilograms) and are walking.

**Chest clip is
at the baby's
armpit level.**



**NEVER place
a rear-facing
seat in front
of an air bag.**

**Straps
are snug.**

**Seat belt or
Universal
Anchorage
System is tight
to hold the seat in
the vehicle.**
